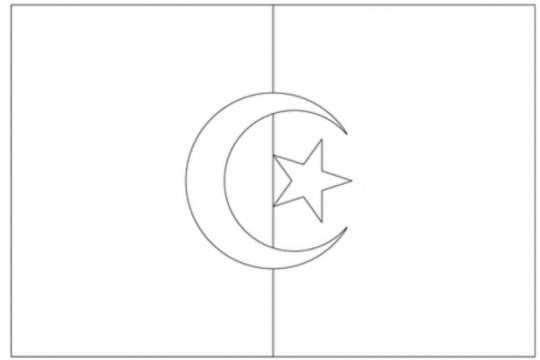
We have provided a page for each country that we have a video for: you may just want to print off one or two or these, or you may want to use the whole pack.
